Which road will your **career** follow?

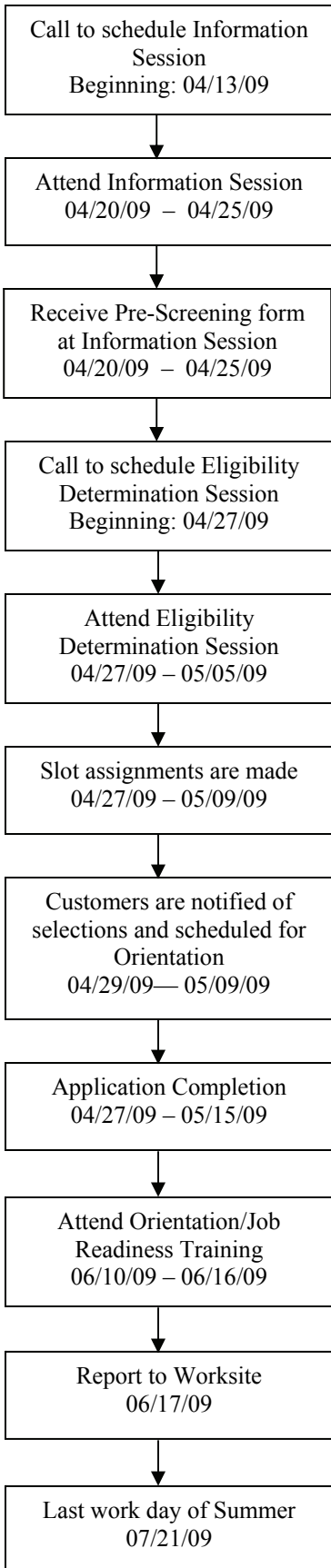
- **Must be between the ages of 14-24**

Summer 2009 Process Flow



What does it mean to be WIA eligible?

It means that you meet one or more defined barriers to employment or educational success **AND** you meet defined low income guidelines. Read on for more details.

Barriers

If you can answer “yes” to one or more of the following questions, then you may meet this eligibility requirement.

- Have you been arrested or in trouble with the law? Are you an Offender or have you been involved with the juvenile justice system?
- Are you behind one or more grade levels in school?
- Are you a high school dropout?
- Are you a runaway?
- Are you pregnant or parenting a child?
- Do you need assistance to complete an educational program?
- Do you need assistance to secure and hold a job?
- Are you a foster child?
- Are you homeless?

Income

If you can answer “yes” to one or more of the following questions, then you may meet this eligibility requirement.

- Does anyone in your household receive Food Stamps (now or at any time in the most recent six (6) months)?
- Do you receive TANF?
- Do you have a disability or an Individual Education Plan?

If you answered “yes” to one or more of the questions above, you may stop here. If not, use the income guidelines below to determine, if based on your income, you might meet this eligibility guideline.

- How many members are there in your household (including yourself): _____
- What is the total income for your household for the **past six (6) month period**:

(Do not include unemployment compensation, child support payments or TANF payments.)

If the total income for your household for the past six (6) months is equal to or less than the amount opposite your family size, you may meet this eligibility requirement.
